Celebrating The Life Of Deacon Eugene Palmer:

Eugene Palmer was born in Gainesville, Alabama on August 17, 1932 to the union of William and Alberta Palmer.

Eugene accepted Jesus Christ as his Savior at an early age. He was educated in the Sumpter County Schools system and received his high school diploma in 1955, shortly after he moved to Detroit in pursuit of better opportunities.

After working several jobs, he was employed by the Cadillac Motor Car Division of General Motors in 1964; he retired after 32.5 years of service.

He united with the Community Baptist Church in 1958 under the pastorate of the late Rev. George Randall. Over the years he served in many capacities including the trustee ministry serving many years as its chairman. He was ordained a deacon under the pastorate of Rev. Charles E. Willis. He later united with the St. Phillips Missionary Baptist Church, under the pastorate of the late Rev. Theron Hodges Sr. He continued to fulfill his role as a deacon and served as its chairman for two years.

Eugene enjoyed reading the Bible, visiting the sick and singing his favorite hymn, "Father I Stretch My Hand to Thee."

During Eugene's early teen years, he met Edna Jackson who he married on June 1, 1957. To this union four children were born: Eugene Kelvin, Reginald, Allen, and Glenda.

Eugene and his eight siblings shared a strong and enduring bond, which continues today.

Eugene departed this life December 16, 2015.
