Frank Eggleston was born on October 1, 1922, in Tillatobia, Mississippi (where he received his early education) to the late James and Rubie Eggleston. He was one of ten children.

Frank Eggleston moved to Detroit, Michigan in 1944 to find better work opportunities. He later met and married Mable Boyd on July 20, 1949, and to this union had two sons and three daughters. They were married for 65 years.

He attended the Apostolic Church of God In Christ Jesus and was baptized by the late Elder Levi Miles and received the Holy Ghost on April 21, 1963. He was appointed to serve as a deacon and then he was later called into the ministry. He became a licensed minister on November 29, 1984. While attending the Apostolic Church of God In Christ Jesus he served under the late Elder Percy Pitts and Bishop Gilbert Allen. With the blessings from Bishop Allen he was able to minister at other local churches as the Lord led him to go. He would also go and minister at the Omni Convalescent Center. On May 5, 2002, he was led to move his membership to the Family Worship Center and assist his son-in-law in the ministry, for whom he was a tremendous encouragement. He had a great passion for serving the Lord, ministering and praying for anyone who was in need. His favorite song and daily goal was, "I Want to Live So God Can Use Me Anywhere and Anytime." His favorite saying

concerning living for God was “It’s a lifestyle.”

He worked at Michigan Precision Industry along with operating his own business (Frank Eggleston Landscaping Co). He retired from Michigan Precision Industry in December 1988 and continued to do landscaping until his health began to fail in 2011.
