### His Story:

Mr. Frank Rufus Roberts, Jr. was born on May 19, 1938 in Detroit, Michigan to Frank and Blanche Roberts.

He accepted Christ at an early age and was a member of Bethel AME Church and also attended The Church of the Living God.

Frank graduated from Northwestern High School in 1956, and attended Wayne State University for several years.

Frank was employed by the United States Postal Service. He started as a Letter Carrier in 1958; and after 34 years, retired from the Special Delivery Division in 1992. He was a long-time member of the American Postal Workers Union (APWU) and continued his activism with the APWU Retiree Community.
