Frankie Pearl Odom was born January 3, 1931 to the late Will and Clara (Johnson) Odom in Macon, Georgia. Orphaned at the age of three, Frankie was brought to Detroit, Michigan by her older and only sister, Catherine (Wilcox) Gilmore. Frankie graduated from Pershing High School in 1949. She was a servant of Christ from an early age. Frankie was baptized in 1944 at Peace Baptist Church. In 1958, she was appointed superintendent of Sunday school at New Redeemer Missionary Baptist Church. She also loved to usher at the various churches she attended over the years.

Frankie worked in food services at Petoskey Hall Nursing Home and Jefferies Elementary School. Later she worked for the state of Michigan doing clerical work. Having always wanted to be a nurse, at the age of 62, Frankie graduated as a medical assistant through the Detroit Area Agency on Aging.

Frankie was always high spirited and independent. Although Frankie lost her sight in 2010, she continued to live on her own until February, 2014 when she was diagnosed with pancreatic cancer at the age of 83. Even after her diagnosis, she continued to be strong in spirit and in her faith in Christ.
