Fred was six years old when his family moved to Detroit, MI. Fred grew up on the east side of Detroit and his educational training was via the Detroit Public School System.

After graduating from high school, Fred joined the U.S. Army Reserves, where he served our country, and received an honorable discharge. Fred also worked at Ford Motor Company for four (4) years as a Spot Welder.

Frederick was joined in holy matrimony to Lisa in 1984. They had one son, Godfrey Arnold, who died as an infant.

Fred was an avid sports fan, and loved watching games on television and in person. His favorite magazine was Hot Rod Magazine. Fred also had a love for playing cards, especially when he was with family.

During the later years of Fred's life he was often hospitalized and spent a lot of time in rehabilitation centers. He never complained, and always bounced
