The Life And Legacy Of Freddie Williams:

Freddie W. Williams was born in Hope Hull, Alabama on January 23, 1934. He was born the eighth child of thirteen children born to the union of Daniel Sr. and Luretha Williams. His beloved parents, his son Donnie, brothers, Willie, George, Jacob, Joe, Jerry, and sisters, Mayola and Terry preceded him in his arrival into eternity.
