His Journey:

George H. Clark Jr. was born on November 17, 1932 in Gloster, Louisiana to George Harmon Clark Sr. and Ellen Hines. He was the third born of four children. His father, mother, brother Arthur and sisters Mildred and Helen preceded him in death.

Seeking a better education for his children, and job opportunities, George Sr. moved his family to Monroe where George Jr. grew up. He attended The Little Flower of Jesus Catholic School through 12th grade, played basketball in high school and graduated in May, 1952.

After high school, he was drafted. Prior to leaving for the Army, where he did two tours of duty in the Korean War, he married his high school sweetheart Ruby Wilson. Two sons were born to this union, Roland Michael Clark and Jerome Anthony Clark.

Always working, George Jr. pursued several careers. In Monroe, Louisiana he worked for Straus Co. in charge of produce distribution. Later he worked for a moving and storage company in Shreveport, Louisiana and attended barber school at the same time.

After working as a (licensed) barber for several years and seeking financial

stability for his family, he packed up his family and moved to Detroit in 1965.

He enjoyed working with his hands and for many years he enjoyed a hobby of making leather wallets, belts and other popular leather items.

George not only worked as a barber, but he also secured a job with General Motors as a job setter at the plant on Holbrook where he worked for 29 years before he retired.

A constant in the lives of George, Ruby and the children was travel. He would drive because as he would so often say, "You never know when you might see something you want to stop and check out." They traveled across the country visiting with relatives and friends and discovering new highways.
