After graduation, he relocated to Detroit, Michigan with his parents. He attended Wayne State University and Lawrence Technical College. George enlisted in the United States Army and served in the Korean War as a Guided Missile Maintenance Engineer for 4 years before he was honorably discharged.

On October 29, 1966 George wed the late Gloria Ann Parker and from that union two children were born, Towana and Kristian. George had enormous love for them, and they were very close. If they weren't hanging out on the boat, he would be at the movies with Kristian or at the mall with Towana. He had to keep her abreast on the latest fashions.

George believed in providing for his family. He worked for the United States

Postal Service as a Maintenance Engineer. Later, he was promoted to Plant Manager of the Bulk Mail Center. George retired after 30 years of faithful service, but soon went back to work as Plant Manager at (RCI). After five years George decided to retire permanently so he could enjoy the fruits of his labor.

George never had a dull moment, if he wasn't boating or fishing, he would be at home cooking or spending time with his children. He knew how to keep himself busy.
