George at the age of 18 joined the U.S. Air Force and spent three years serving. Once at home he saw the prettiest girl on the west side, and said one day she's going to be his wife... 65 years later he still has the prettiest lady on the west side, Bobbette Carey Cook.

George and Bobbette have two children, Daryl and Cheryl.

George Cook was a very hard working man. He worked at Awrey Bakery as a supervisor for 25 years with perfect attendance.

In 1970 George and Bobbette purchased their first Baskin Robbins 31 Flavor Ice Cream Store ... a few years later they bought a party store called Cooks Corner Party Shoppe. A few years later they bought another Baskin Robbins on the Avenue of Fashion. They were the first Black Baskin Robbins franchise store owners. They stayed in business for over 40 years.

George Cook went back to school at age 75, graduated with a 4.0 GPA and the promise to his mom was fulfilled.

George was in the Shriners. He was a 33rd Degree Masson and a Honorary Past Imperial Potentate (HPIP) for the Consistory Grand Inspector General (GIG) and Past Master in Hiram Lodge #1.

George's last words were take care of mama.
