She worked as an industrial seamstress at General Motors Fisher Body plant in Livonia years ago until an injury placed her into a disability retirement. Gertha loved doing various things, but nothing could compare to the love she had as a servant of the Lord. She loved singing in the choir, going to bible study, prayer meetings and Sabbath service to give worship and praise to God Almighty. She loved and knew the Lord and wanted nothing but for all her family and friends to know the Lord Christ Jesus as their saving grace and personal savior.

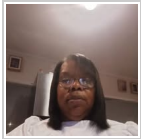
