



Mrs. Gladys Lowe

December 4, 1933 - April 22, 2014

Mrs. Gladys (Brown) Lowe was born December 4, 1933 to the union of Clyde Brown and Willie Mae Barnes in Greenville, Georgia - both parents preceded her in death. She was the fourth child in a family of ten children.

While in Georgia, Gladys accepted Jesus Christ as her Savior and was baptized at an early age. Gladys moved from Greenville, Georgia to Ferndale, Michigan in 1951. Shortly after arriving in Michigan, Gladys received a license in cosmetology and began working as a cosmetologist.

On October 23, 1954, Gladys Brown was united in holy matrimony with Louis A. Lowe. The marriage lasted 40 years until Louis' death in 1994. Out of this union three children (Pamela, André, and Angela) were born.

In 1966, Gladys began working in the Detroit Public Schools system as a teacher's assistant at William H. Peck Elementary, and later Durfee Middle School, while still working as a beautician at her in-home shop on Friday evenings and Saturdays. Gladys enjoyed working with children. She retired from the Detroit Public Schools System in 1996, after 30 years of service.

In 1968, Gladys joined New Prospect Missionary Baptist Church in Detroit, where she served as a choir member at the church until she could no longer participate, due to health challenges.

Gladys introduced her children (at an early age) to Jesus Christ by engaging the family in prayer, reading Bible stories at home and by mandatory attendance to Sunday School, Vacation Bible School, and church services.

Gladys was a fun and loving mother, wife, grandmother, sister and friend. She enjoyed family, laughing, working, baking, singing, sewing, reading, learning, attending church, helping others whenever she could, and watching Tiger Woods.

After battling for many years, Gladys finally succumbed to the accumulation of health challenges that plagued her. She was often in pain and with limited mobility, however, she still found a way to laugh and enjoy visitations from friends and family.
