Gwendolyn Debra Moore was born on April 17, 1961 to Barbara and Otis Hawkins in Detroit, MI.

Gwendolyn was the younger of two children. Her parents preceded her in death.

Gwendolyn was educated in the Detroit Public School system and graduated from Henry Ford High School in 1979, where she earned city and state honors in basketball and track. After graduating she was awarded a full athletic scholarship for basketball to the University of Michigan-Dearborn. After a knee injury ended her college basketball career, she transferred to Lawrence Technological University, where she received an Associates Degree in Data Processing and a Baccalaureate in Business Administration in 1986.

Gwendolyn earned a certificate as a Project Management Professional (PMP) in 2007.

Gwendolyn worked in various positions as an employee and a contractor across many industries (Human Resources, Utility, City and State Government and Financial Services).

Gwendolyn was a volunteer with Pro-Literacy Detroit, Gleaners and Forgotten Harvest Food Banks, Free Press Marathon and a mentor with Cornerstone

Schools.

Gwendolyn received Christ at the age of 12 and was baptized at Central C.M.E. Church in Detroit, MI. Gwendolyn loved to sing and was a member of the choir until she left Central in 1981. She joined the Rejoice Community Choir and the Gospel Music Workshop of America, where the choirs performed throughout Detroit and across the country from 1981-1986. She became a member of IDMR where she continued her religious studies and beliefs until her passing.

Gwendolyn met the love of her life, Kevin in 1987 on the job (CareerWorks) where they became very good friends. Their friendship blossomed into love and they were happily married in 1989.

Gwendolyn departed this life on May 31, 2015 after battling a rare form of cancer.
