Her Journey:

Helen Jean Stephens was eighty-five when she departed this life on August 3, 2018 after several years of poor health. She was born on December 3, 1932. Her parents were the late C. W. Flowers and Donzetta Skinner from Brundage, Alabama. The Flowers family moved to the Detroit area some years later. Mom married Floyd Stephens in her teen years. After some time, our mother became a single parent with four children to care for. With the strong support of her mother, Donzetta, faith in God, perseverance, determination, and an unrelenting commitment of love for her children and her immediate family, her major goals were achieved for herself and her children. Two major goals in Mom's life was finishing her education; in addition, she wanted her children to complete their education through college or obtain a job to support their independence. Both goals were accomplished. Helen Jean Stephens studied hard to obtain her GED High School Diploma, BA degree from Wayne State University for Sociology, and finally a Masters of Sociology from Wayne State.

Helen worked several years as a Social Worker for Neighborhood Social Services in the Brewster Projects and Catholic Social Services. Mother helped anyone she could from family members, foster children, unwed mothers, and senior citizens in the community. As a Social Worker, she was primary therapist for individuals and families; assessed family dynamics; established

family goals and therapeutic interventions. She provided preventative community mental health to individuals and groups. Helen served as a liaison between clients and social agencies to facilitate community maintenance for individuals, families and groups. Mother maintained case records, provided emergency services, and crisis intervention. Although Mom's health declined in her latter years she continued to vote at every election; including casting her vote for the first black President, Barack Obama in 2008 and 2012.

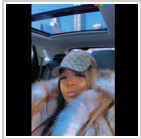
