My Story:

Henry Lee Rozier of Detroit, MI made his transition from this life on Monday, February 10, 2014. He was with us for 87 years. Henry was born on August 21, 1926 in Columbus, GA to Oscar and Mattie (McGrudder) Rozier. In that time families were large and the Roziers' were no different, eight children were born to Oscar and Mattie. Henry was crafty and very good with his hands, but unfortunately like many others from his time, he was not afforded the opportunity to finish his education in a traditional school environment. Times were often very hard but he watched and learned as he went throughout his life. Like many young southern men of his time, he was forced into separation from his family because his life was in danger. Henry accepted his circumstances and made the best of what God had provided him with. He settled in metro Detroit which became his permanent home and enjoyed being behind the wheel of any machine that he built a living from; a career as a trolley car operator and then a bus driver for the Department of Transportation. Henry accepted the call to serve his country in WWII and enlisted in the U.S. Army, which resulted in an honorable discharge for that commitment.

In April 1960, he married Frankolene Hones, and together they merged and extended a family which consisted of three daughters, Sandra (Johnson), Suzanne (Pryor), Sheila (Harris) and two sons, Douglas and Paul Sr. Henry

served as a proud member of the Detroit Police Reserves for over 20 years and was gifted in all types of mechanical and crafting applications. A unique soul, Henry was sometimes very quiet and reserved, and other times he enjoyed being visible and loud.

For all that Henry was or was not, his true calling in life was on the golf course. He had an amazing stroke and was skilled in both long and short aspects of the game. There are many that tell stories of his accomplishments as admirers will often do. He was a professional's pro and he will be greatly missed.
