



## Mr. Houston Stuckey

July 14, 1936 - September 25, 2013

Houston Stuckey, affectionately known as “Man”, was born July 14, 1936 in Bentonia, Mississippi to the late Dennis Stuckey and Etta LaFlore-Stuckey. The family later moved to Yazoo City, Mississippi. Houston was the third of twelve children, three of which preceded him in death, Annie B., Louis D. and Herbert.

He received Christ at an early age, and joined New Pleasant Grove Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Reverend W. K. Watkins. He was a graduate of Yazoo City High in Yazoo City, Mississippi. In 1959 he was drafted into the U. S. Armed Forces, 2nd MTB-35th Armor, and served until 1963. He was also drafted for a second Tour of Duty and received honorable discharges from both.

In 1968 he made Detroit, Michigan his home and in 1974 he married the love of his life Barbara Cheeves-Stuckey. Although no children were born to this union, they were devoted God Parents to Derric and Dejah James and Darrin Hunt. Houston worked for and retired from IBEW and Detroit Public Schools. He was an active member of New Light Baptist Church until his health failed him. Houston (Man) Stuckey departed this life at 5:15 p.m. September 25, 2013 at Kindred Hospital in Detroit, Michigan.
