He also owned and operated his own Mister Softy Ice Cream Truck. He received many honors and citation from the community and local government for his outstanding contribution to the local community.

Imim at an early age enjoyed motorcycle racing, roller skating, ballroom dancing at the Greystone and Madison Ballroom. He loved laughing, telling stories that would go on for hours, and spending time with family and friends.
