Inez attended and graduated from Dunbar High School where she was an active member of the marching band. While attending Dunbar High School Inez met Johnie L. Eaton. After graduating from high school Johnie and Inez were united in holy matrimony. To this union was born Doris, Charles, and Jeffrey.
