“ *I grew up in the LaSalle Gardens neighborhood in Detroit, Michigan on LaSalle Gardens S. The adults in our neighborhood were very organized when it came to keeping a stable, safe environment for us children to grow & thrive. The Colliers were one of the families that helped to provide that for us. I was born into that community & as far back as I can remember, the Colliers were always there. Some of my earliest memories I have of exercising my independence was when I was about 2 or 3 years old, telling my mom I was "going to the store", of course I wasn't because I wasn't allowed to cross the street & I had no money; I would go to visit my "girlfriend" Mrs. Collier! I'd ring the doorbell, we'd greet, I'd go in & hang out for a few minutes & then go home. I never knew my Mother was watching what I was doing, & would often be on the phone with Mrs. Collier while I was there. That might seem to be a lack luster memory, but it stands out to me because it's a simple thing that my children don't have. The world we live in today seems to be a lot less innocent & safe. I feel I have to be much more guarded with my children then it seems my parents had to be with me & my sisters. It's a simple, special relationship that I had with Mrs. Collier that speaks to the innocence of a simpler time. May Allah be pleased with Irene Collier. 😊🙏*
