Isabelle Hall was born May 26, 1920, to Julia and Jack Hall in Georgiana, Alabama. The family moved to Detroit, Michigan's black bottom neighborhood in the late 1920s. Isabelle was the oldest of seven siblings – Herman, Edward, Alfreda, and Pastella, who all preceded her in death.

Isabelle attended Detroit Public Schools, graduating from Cass Technical High School in 1929 where she studied Accounting. Although Isabelle was extremely smart, due to the climate of the world in the 1940s she could only work in the factories where she proudly earned money to support her family. She used her accounting skills and became the H&R Block of the family doing taxes for many years.

Belle, as she was fondly known, was very no nonsense and had a witty personality. Belle told it like it was and could challenge you on most subjects. Everyone loved talking to Belle because she always told you something you didn't know.

She was the matriarch in her family for most of her life and took pride in caring for her younger siblings.

Belle loved sports; watching the Detroit Tigers and Lions often asking, "so what do you think about..."? Her love for going to the racetrack, the casino, and the movies lasted for most of her life.

Belle was very tech savvy and enjoyed spending time on her electronics confidently navigating the internet from her phone, tablets, and computer. She was blessed at her age with a clear mind and an amazing memory; she knew

who you were and remembered exactly what she told you to do.

She loved to eat pizza and enjoyed BBQ on the weekends. In her earlier years, Belle would cook French toast and share her Ambrosia dish at every family gathering.

Belle had a relationship with God and talked to him often. She also enjoyed spending time talking with her neighbors in the Evangelica Manor where she lived for over 30 years.
