Ivory Jean Thomas was born Ivory Jean Hall on June 5, 1924 in Seminole, Oklahoma. She was the only child of the late Carolyn Brock and Sidney Hall. Ivory was educated in the Oklahoma school system. She accepted Christ as a young child at the Old Landmark Church in Oklahoma. She later found a Christian home at Springhill Missionary Baptist Church, where she remained until she united with Oak Park Missionary Baptist Church and served as a deaconess and member of the mother's board.

Ivory was united in holy matrimony with John Henry Thomas on March 26, 1972. With this union she gained one stepson George who preceded her in death, and three stepdaughters, Varnell, Karen, and Brenda.

Ivory worked as a care giver at the Royal Nursing Home in Highland Park. She later worked as a supervisor at Tot-Town day care center. This is where she became known as Miss Ivory.

She belonged to the Eastern Star Guiding Light Chapter No. 50. She served as Worthy Matron in 1978 and then again from 1987 to 1989.

Miss Ivory departed this life on December 1, 2014 at Henry Ford Hospital.
