



## Mr. Jackson Louis Lee

Jackson Lee was born on May 13, 1928 to the union of Jackson Lee, Sr. and Juanita Handy in Danville, Georgia. Both parents preceded him in death. Jackson was the third oldest of nine children; Edith, Kager (Pete), Maryann, Marguerite, Adell, Johnny (deceased), Damus (deceased) and Willie (deceased).
