James Marion Cooper was born to James and Ellen Cooper on Mother's Day 1942. He was the oldest of their 3 children. When newborn James was presented to his mother, the nurse told her, "You have a fine looking chap here." The name stuck. He was affectionately known to most as Chappy.

He grew up in Conant Gardens and was educated in Detroit Public Schools. He graduated from Wilbur Wright High School in 1959. He married his high school sweetheart Shirley Holmes in 1960. To this union was born three children: Ellen, Bertrand and Stacey.

Chappy worked in skilled trades as a tool and die draftsman until he became disabled in the 1990s due to an accident. In 1997, he married Alma Bradley. She remained with him through the eventual medical complications that resulted in his death.
