Rev. James Charlie Hilliard, of Southfield Michigan, returned to his heavenly home on October 21, 2020.

Reverend Hilliard was born on July 21, 1946 in Monroe, Louisiana to the late Nancy Lee Hilliard and Charlie Hilliard. Rev. Hilliard accepted Christ as his personal savior at the age of twelve and served as a Junior Deacon and Deacon before accepting his call to ministry. In 1970 Rev. Hilliard graduated from Carrol High School in Monroe, Louisiana. He also earned an associate degree in Business administration from Grambling State University in Louisiana where he became a member of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity Inc., Gamma Gamma Chapter. He was licensed and ordained to preach the gospel and has labored in God's vineyard ever since. Rev. Hilliard was called to Pastor the New Galilee Baptist Church in Monroe, Louisiana from 1978-1987. In 1987 the Lord led Rev. Hilliard to serve as Assistant to the Pastor at the Historic Little Rock Baptist Church in Detroit under the leadership of Rev. Jim Holley. Rev. Hilliard served as Associate District Executive of the Boy Scouts of America, Detroit Council from 1976-1978. He also served on the National Baptist Counsel, as Chaplain of the Michigan State Troopers, and a member of the NAACP.

Rev. Hilliard was blessed with a loving family. He married the love of his life Marilyn Faye Leonard on September 15, 1972 which was the first wedding Rev. Holley performed when the church was located on Maxwell and Warren.

They were happily married for 48 years.
