James Marvin Masterson, the son of Maceo Masterson and Ethel Grainger Masterson, was born on September 9, 1930 in Detroit, Michigan.

Marvin, as he was called, was graduated from Northwestern High School. There he had the nickname "Pete." After graduation, Marvin matriculated at Highland Park Community College. A recruiter from Ford Motor Company went to the college offering an apprenticeship program. Marvin took advantage of that opportunity. He became an apprentice then progressed to become a journeyman in the skilled trades. He was a machine repairman in the tool and die unit. Marvin loved his job and worked 53-1/2 years at Ford Motor Company.

Marvin was an Army Veteran who had participated in the Korean War. He was honorably discharged, and he furthered his military interest through service in the Veteran of Foreign Wars.

On August 12, 1966, Marvin was united in marriage with Althea. The marriage lasted 53 years. They became parents to three sons. He was a loving husband and devoted father.

Marvin was a lifetime Lutheran. He was a member of Berea Lutheran Church. He transferred his membership to Outer Drive Faith Lutheran Church where he served faithfully until his health failed. He had been an elder, co-chairperson of the finance board, an usher, treasurer of the Men of Faith, trustee, and church council. A great joy to him was the Wednesday Morning

Bible Class. His favorite Bible verse was Matthew 6:33 - "But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things will be given to you."
