Celebrating The Legacy Of Rev. James Harold Moseley, Sr.:

Reverend James Harold Moseley Sr. was born June 21, 1949 to the late Elias Morris and Ora Lee Moseley, from that union nine children were born of which four siblings preceded him in death.

He was educated in Detroit Public Schools system and graduated from Western High in 1966. James (affectionately known as "Harold" by most) enlisted in the U.S. Army in 1969 and served until he was honorably discharged. He confessed his love for Christ at an early age and was baptized at Burnett Baptist Church. James was ordained at Prince of Peace Missionary Baptist Church. He helped with the organization of the Greater Ebenezer Baptist Church. He also served actively at several other churches as an associate minister and teacher. Before his home calling, he was a faithful member of the Davison Missionary Baptist Church under Reverend Dr. David M. Yarber, Sr.

James was a Chaplain at the Highland Park Police Department for several years, he also worked for several funeral homes, including his present employment with O. H. Pye, III.

James married Doris Scott in 1971 and to that union there were seven children. In 2006, James married Sonya Denise Lundy and to that union two

sons, Tremayne R. Lundy and Joshua James Moseley, whom both preceded him in death.

James was a kindhearted, happy, lovable, and well spoken man. He enjoyed playing cards, cracking jokes to make people laugh. He had a very special way of toughing many hearts.

The memory of Reverend James Harold Moseley Sr. will linger for years to come for all those who have crossed his path.
