Sister Janet Simpson was born October 31, 1937 to the union of James and Mildred Billington in East St. Louis, Illinois. Both parents preceded her in death. Janet was the oldest of 3 children, the twins Michael and Michelle. The family moved to Michigan while Janet was still a child. She attended Detroit Public Schools and graduated from Central High School.

Janet met and married Clifford Simpson, who preceded her in death. To that union five sons were born. Janet traveled with her husband during the early part of his military career. Upon returning to Michigan, she held several different jobs and attended Marygrove College where she achieved her certification in medical billing. Upon completion she began a career with Sinai (Sinai Grace) Hospital which she retired from after 30 years.

Janet became a faithful member of the Westside Church of Christ in 1962, where she became a member of The Voice of Joy Chorus, taught bible classes along with the Multiple Sister Ministries. In 1971, the leadership at Westside Church of Christ collectively decided to purchase what is now the Northwest Church of Christ due to the need of a westside location. Along with the leadership she was one of the pioneers that came to the new location for worship. Janet became part of the Northwest Choir, continued teaching and being part of the Church of Christ Ladies' Ministries which included: ladies weekend retreats for song services, luncheons, visiting and home bible classes for the sick, with the choir for concerts as well as the Northwest Lady's

Love Tea and Lady's Day.

Sister Simpson was a faithful member of Northwest until her health prevented her attending.
