Jarvis Henry Lambert was born on May 20, 1920 in Princeton, AK to the late Ed Lambert and Ida Lambert. Jarvis was the eighth child of nine children. He was predeceased by all his siblings.

Jarvis left home in 1942 to join the United States Army, where he received numerous decorations including the World War II Victory Ribbon, Good Conduct Medal, American Theater Ribbon, AP Theatre Ribbon and Two Bronze Service Stars. With an honorable discharge, Jarvis returned home in 1946.

Jarvis eventually moved to California where he was employed at a few jobs. In 1967, Jarvis decided to visit his friend George in Detroit, MI and was invited on a blind date with one Madeline Morris. This wonderful union led Jarvis to remain in Michigan and marry Madeline in 1968 and to begin a family.

Jarvis worked for Wayne County Road Commison to give his family a great life. He retired from the county in 1982.

Jarvis lived 93 years and has left wonderful memories with family, friends and everyone he touched with his great stories and wise advice. Jarvis Henry Lambert was a great man that will live on in our hearts forever.
