Jessie Mae Cooper, 90 years old, was born to the late William (Willie) Knight and Johnnie Mae (Lackley) Knight on December 13, 1930 in Perry, Georgia peacefully returned to God on May 6, 2021. Cherished memories left to 4 children, 16 grandchildren and 5 great-grandchildren.

Mrs. Jessie Mae Cooper, a strong leader, caring was an entrepreneur at heart. From a young child she collected pecans from the backyard tree and sold them to neighbors to make their cakes and pies. She was one of the first organic chicken growers, refusing to add chemicals to her chicken feed as suggested by the chemical company to make the chickens breast bigger. She sold her organic chickens to local grocery stores and restaurants in the area. She bought a home as a single woman long before women's rights and it was commonplace for a woman to be self-sufficient, much less purchase a home. She worked a short-time in the automotive industry, involving herself in union activities – again not heard of for a woman in those days.

Mrs. Jessie Cooper was a strong woman providing many lessons of strength, capability, endurance, compassion, and love. One lesson that will always be remembered is her compassion for others. Healing soup they called it. When anyone was ill, mom made homemade chicken and vegetable soup and delivered it, praying them back to health. She was always there to take in a stray cat, dog or even a whole family in need of shelter. Her kindness will never be forgotten by many.

Quite the cook, she told the story of as a child too short to reach the stove top, standing on a box to be able to stir the homemade pudding to make a banana pudding. Her apple pies were famous, and she baked and sold them to the community and local restaurant. And the love of her delicious, canned pear preserve made from the pear tree in her backyard was cherished by the family, neighbors and anyone who was so fortunate to get a taste of it. Mom loved sharing her faith, music, dancing, traveling with her women's group and family, or just sharing a cup of coffee or bowl of her homemade soup on the front porch.

Yes, Ms. Jessie will be missed, but her legacy will always be remembered and take its place in our heart.

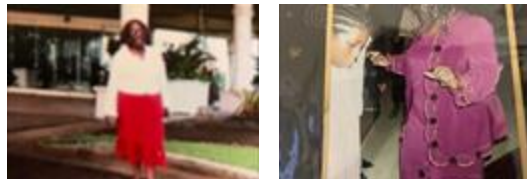
