Joella Jones was born in Goodwin, AK in 1913 on December 24, to Joseph and Betsy Lyons. In May of 1923 Joella and the family of two older sisters and one younger brother and her parents moved to Detroit, Michigan. Joella attended school in Detroit and Inkster only to the sixth grade of education.

In 1931, Joella married William Perdue. To that union born three children were born;, William Jr., Edward and Juanita Perdue. As a young wife and mother, Joella gave her life to Christ and was born again in 1932 at Clinton Street Bethlehem Temple, under the late Bishop S.N. Hancock, where she attended many years.
