In 1976, he received an Associate Degree in Accounting from Highland Park Community College and in 1978 he received a Bachelor's Degree in Accounting from the Detroit College of Business.

Throughout his career, he was employed with Consolidated Computer and Accounting Services as a junior and senior accountant and with Great Lakes Transmission Company as a budget analyst.
