John Edward Morton was born June 20, 1947 in Detroit, Michigan to the late Albert and Ola J. Morton. He was the middle child of three boys, with older brother Alan Curtis and younger brother, the late Michael Arnold.

John graduated from Detroit Chadsey High School in 1966. He was drafted into the United States Army in 1967 and was honorably discharged in 1972. John returned briefly to Detroit after leaving the Army and worked at Ford Motor Company, but his real passion was music. John decided to try his luck in the music industry and moved to California where he lived for several years. He would often send news back to the family in Detroit of his “celebrity” encounters.

John eventually returned home to Detroit to be closer to family. He trained and worked as an EMT and as a security guard before health concerns forced him to retire. He married Valerie Denise Mack in 1995.

John came to know Christ and joined Bible way COGIC where he was active in the music ministry. His wife Valerie preceded him in death in 2009.

He departed this life on March 16, 2015 after a brief illness. He was greatly loved and will be missed by everyone.
