His Journey:

John Logan Sadler was born in Detroit, Michigan to the union of the late John and Ella Sadler on November 8, 1954. He was the oldest of four children.

He began his magnanimous music career at the precious age of two when he made his debut at the International Gospel Center in Southwest Detroit by skillfully playing, "Reach Out and Touch the Lord." His musical legacy encompassed 57 years of experience working with such gospel greats as the Mighty Clouds of Joy, Shirley Caesar, the Violinaires (with our own gospel great, Rev. James Byers), Dorothy Love Coates, James Cleveland, Dr. Mattie Moss Clark, and J. Moss, to just mention a few. Historically, he was inducted into the Gospel Hall of Fame with Bill Moss and the Celestials in 2004; and conducted the Montreaux musical seminar in 1994. He has been a member of Leland Missionary Baptist Church since 1995 and shared his musical expertise for 17 consecutive years with each choir which includes the Messiah Choir, Male Chorus, Combined Choirs, Inspirational Choir, and Youth Choir.

On June 18, 2011, an especially beautiful, God-blessed day, John Logan Sadler married Kathleen Smith, and they became as one. Their love, as husband and wife, was sanctioned by the presence of God. On this occasion, John realized that "Whoso findeth a wife findeth a good thing, and obtaineth favour of the Lord." (Proverbs 18:22).
