John Wilson Teamer, referred to by family as "JACK", entered this world the thirteenth day, of October, 1918. Being born the third child of sixteen to Ora and Charlie Teamer gave him passion for family (good food and family gatherings) John was born into a GOD loving spiritually filled family so it's no surprise that he accepted Christ at an early age and less surprising that he met the love of his life, Evelyn Claybon, at church.

In 1939 John and Evelyn were united in holy matrimony, a union lasting just short of 70 years, nurturing four children and ten grandchildren was their priority. The couple took every opportunity to take their children (home to Tennessee) for Christmas, fourth of July family reunions and for hunting season so John could hunt with his brothers.

Jack loved country western music and digging in the earth, cultivating the soil in his garden and watching vegetables and flowers grow was his favorite task during summer months. The vegetables were canned and frozen then the remaining given away.

John worked as a skilled tradesman in wet plastering and carpentry. His precision and mastering of his craft created high demand for his work. Jack was always improving his home. Literally he'd demolish a room and almost

rebuild it in a day. His children would sing... "This is the house that Jack built Y'all" ...

After retiring from his life's work John established Triple "T" Rental LLC, property management company. At one point the business consisted of 20 dwellings. His children took over leadership in 2009. The gift of building was inherited from his mother's menfolks who built homes in the south and the entrepreneurship inherited from his father.

Loved and adored by his children, grandchildren and great-grandchildren. John's presence will be greatly missed. He has added much value to our lives and his love will remain in our hearts forever.
