Only the bravest & strongest School Social Workers (SSWs) can work in Child Day Treatment/ Adolescent Day Treatment [CDT/ ADT], in Smith Academy/ McKinney / Turning Point [TPA], where I myself worked, 1999-2012. It was at the latter campus of Von Steuben, named after Baron Freidrich Willhelm Ludolf Gerhard Augustin Von Steuben (1730-1794), that Mrs. McCray performed an intake for a student who had to be transferred from a Less Restrictive Environment [LRE] Emotionally Impaired [EI] program. I was part of the sending team from my post at Fisher Upper (“the big F/U”), in late 2016-17. Mrs. McCray was professional & well-organized as she welcomed the student & family, taking them through the lengthy process. Also aiding in the process, of course, was the TPA administration & the rest of the staff, led by Mrs. McCray.
~ Yet Mrs. McCray was also a loyal member of Michigan Association of School Social Workers, Region D {MASSW-D). She tried to keep up her annual dues & attended occasional meetings. She knew that there is power in numbers & that Detroit SSWs must be represented.
