Johnny O'Quinn was born to Maryland Paradise and Johnny Clay O'Quinn on August 9, 1929. He was the only child born to this union. Johnny was born and raised by Joshua Hayes in Memphis, Tennessee then moved to Detroit, Michigan.

Johnny attended the Memphis School system until he found work in a factory. In 1946, Johnny married Jessie Lee Fultz and to this union three children were born. They divorced 1963.

In 1948, he enlisted in the U.S. Air Force and while in the service he received his G.E.D. and was a mechanic in the motor pool. In 1965, he received his honorable discharge.

Johnny was introduced to God at an early age. He joined C.M.B.C. in 1986. He was ordained as Deacon, January 1995. In 2005, he became Chairman of the Deacon Board. In 2007, he decided to rededicate his life under the leadership of Pastor Richardson.

In November 2009, he became ill and needed around-the-clock care. In spite of that he was still the comedian, prayer warrior and performed deacon work at the nursing home.

On April 4, 2013 at 11:29 a.m., God sent His angels down to carry Deacon Johnny O'Quinn home.
