“ *Shared a plot of ground in South Vietnam with Joe Brown, back for most of 1969, when we served together in the U. S. Army. Joe was one of our very good soldiers, who walked the bush for most of his tour of duty there in the Recon Platoon of Echo Company, 1st Battalion, 46th Infantry, 196th Light Infantry Brigade, 23rd Infantry Division. Our unit's forward fire base was LZ Professional in Quang Tin Province.*

Joe served much of his time in the jungle as the RTO (Radio Telephone Operator) for the Platoon Leader. So had the added hardship of carrying the heavy radio, as well as the normal needed gear of ammo and food, etc. Have had the opportunity in September 2013, to speak briefly with Joe's Wife, Marilyn, and with his Daughter, Akilah. Our Echo Company group has had several reunions and some of our guys had spoken to Joe, but we had not convinced him to join us yet. We should have kept trying.

Rest in Peace, Joe Brown. You are fondly remembered by your Echo Company family of brothers from Vietnam.
