Juanita Dolores Hinton was born on January 11, 1955, in Pineville, Louisiana, to the late George A. Hinton, Sr. and the late Dolores D. Hinton. She graduated from River Rouge High School in 1973. Shortly thereafter, Juanita began her professional career at Great Lakes Steel, where she worked for approximately ten years.

Seeking new opportunities, Juanita transitioned to the Michigan Department of Corrections, dedicating fifteen years as a Correctional Field Service Assistant and Resident Unit Officer. Committed to personal and professional growth, she pursued higher education at Wayne State University's School of Social Work earning two degrees; a Bachelor of Social Work in 1985 and a Master of Social Work in 1999.

Following her graduate studies, Juanita served as a Supervisor and Social Work Consultant for nine years. During this period, she further enhanced her expertise by obtaining a Graduate Certificate in Advanced Social Work Practice from Wayne State University in 2007.

A military child accustomed to relocation, Juanita moved to Killeen, Texas, in 2009. There, she devoted nine years to the United States Army Medical Evaluation Board at Fort Hood Military Base, where as a Licensed Clinical Social Worker, Juanita distinguished herself by conducting complex and comprehensive psychosocial evaluations, addressing behavioral and mood disorders, PTSD, traumatic brain injuries, and behavioral health intervention and resource needs for active-duty service members.

In 2018, upon returning to Michigan, Juanita established her own psychotherapy practice. Known for her versatility and entrepreneurial spirit, she also embraced the role of educator, serving as an adjunct professor at Central Texas College and Wayne County Community College.

Though her career was marked by dedication and achievement, Juanita's life was richly balanced with joy and passion. She loved to travel and was always eagerly planning her next adventure. An enthusiast of concerts, shows, and exhibits, she took great delight in dressing elegantly, sharing her style with loved ones, and spending time with friends at these events. Her captivating smile and radiant presence made a lasting impression— Juanita was truly a class act, unforgettable whenever she entered a room.

Above all else, Juanita's greatest love was for her nieces and nephews. Though she had no children of her own, her devotion and affection for them were evident. She especially shared a unique and valued relationship with her niece Devona, while always extending her love and support to all of her nieces and nephews.
