Mrs. Julia Mae Hunt, daughter of the late Julius Owens and Bernice (Sims) Owens, was born on March 21, 1933 in Birmingham, Alabama. She attended the public schools of Birmingham City Board of Education and was a graduate of what was known as the largest high school for Negroes at the time, A.H. Parker High School. At an early age she professed her faith in Jesus Christ and joined the 16th Street Baptist Church where she was a dedicated member. She was united in holy matrimony to Owen (Pete) Hunt Jr. in January of 1955. This union was blessed with six children. Owen Hunt Jr. preceded her in death on March 13, 1993.

In 2017, Julia joined First United Church of Jesus Christ Apostolic where she rededicated her life to Jesus Christ and was baptized. She loved attending church services and fellowshiping with the saints. Her favorite outing was the annual church picnic, an event she never missed.

Mrs. Hunt worked for the Detroit Board of Education for over 35 years as a Food Service Coordinator. As a result of her generous spirit, pleasant personality, and all of the educators and children she worked with, she was loved by many. She had many hobbies that she excelled at. She played golf and was a proud member of the Detroit Free Press Women's Golf League. She was a seamstress and would design many beautiful gowns including wedding and prom dresses, gardener, and probably her signature hobby, baking those 7-up and cream cheese pound cakes. Her life was as beautiful
