Kristal Davina Caldwell was born on March 9, 1969. She was the first of three children born to the loving union of David and Christine Everett. As a young lady, she was very active. Although there were many activities she participated in, she really enjoyed playing the flute and being a member of the Detroit Starlets, a baton and dance group led by her aunt, Marie Valentine.

She accepted Christ at a young age as a member of the family church, Davison Missionary Baptist Church. Kristal attended Peter J. Vetal Elementary and Middle School and she continued on to Cooley High School, both Detroit Public Schools. While at Cooley, she was in the Cooley Accelerated Program (C.A.P) and many school activities, her favorite being a member of the Cooley High School Marching Band. She furthered her education by obtaining her Associates Degree in Business from Henry Ford Community College, her Bachelor's Degree from the University of Michigan - Dearborn in Business and Finance, and her MBA (Masters of Business Administration) from the University of Phoenix.

Kristal met her husband, Lawrence while in high school. After dating for a while, they married on August 27, 1994. To this union a son was born, Larenz Kristopher. Kristal became active in the church and was a founding member of House of Prayer COGIC. There she served in the church choir, Vice President

of the Women's' Department and wherever else she was needed.

She flourished professionally in all endeavors and let nothing hold her back.
