On March 15, 1975, Willie Harold Montgomery, Sr. and Ruthie Bledsoe-Montgomery gave birth to a beautiful baby girl. La'Nier was born at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital in Detroit, Michigan. She graduated from Frank Cody High School in 1993 and later attended Grambling State University, majoring in biology. La'Nier accepted Jesus Christ at a young age while attending Silver Star Baptist Church under the leadership of the late Pastor Vassel. She later rededicated her life and joined Temple of Faith Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Rochelle Davis. During these formative years, La'Nier sang in the youth choir, worked on the youth usher board, Act-Teen youth missionary group, youth drama team and the Mime Praise Dance ministry. La'Nier had one biological son, Shawn Mims, Jr., and they had a remarkable bond. La'Nier was also affectionately called mother by so many of Shawn's friends (Alex, Deonte, Aireal, Kiara, and Latisha). When you visited her home, you knew you would have fun and see dance-off challenges with her and Shawn acting silly. They spent countless hours doing workout routines to make sure they would win. She also planned Christmas celebrations that were full of love, games, delicious food and gifts for everyone who came. This care and generosity for others was normal behavior for La'Nier and we appreciated every moment.

For those who really knew La'Nier, so many wonderful memories immediately come to mind. We can't help but smile when we think about how much she

enjoyed family fellowships and doing little things that brought people joy. La'Nier had a glow. She was that person who could walk into a dark room and light it up with her smile. Her attitude was always positive and she had a heart of pure gold. She also had a phenomenal sense of humor and a way of expressing herself that brought waves of laughter throughout the room. La'Nier was called the life of the party because she was always dancing, playing music, singing and would try anything to get us to have a good time. La'Nier had high expectations, too, and planned unexpected visits to her brother's home to create TikTok videos; which to this day, were never posted because no one could get the dance steps right...at least to her satisfaction. When La'Nier was diagnosed with Lymphoma Cancer, on March 14, 2018, her strong faith in God grew, and she developed a more intimate relationship with Christ as she battled and overcame cancer. Despite this challenging journey, La'Nier still took pride in her appearance – especially her hair and makeup - and would always look flawless. Her life was full of grace, an inspiration to all and her memories will serve as the foundation of her legacy.
