Home Going Celebration For Laculia Walker:

Laculia Foulks was born on September 23, 1922 in Rosser, Tennessee to Virgie Hampton Foulks and Jefferson Foulks. They both preceded her in death. She was the fifth out of ten children, in which eight have preceded her in death: Hulon Foulks, Herbert Ozell (Dimple) Foulks, Veddie Foulks-Dupree, Coetta Foulks-Porter, Willie Jeff Foulks, Oliver James Foulks, Rufus Odell Foulks, and Roger Lee Foulks.

Laculia had one daughter, Peggy Hart by her first marriage. In 1947, she married David Walker in Tennessee and the family moved to Detroit, Michigan where she became a nurse's aide at Harper Hospital until she retired in 1983.
