Lamont Adrian Fuggett entered this world on January 23, 1972 in Detroit, MI to Linda D. Fuggett and Otis Petty. He was raised from a young age by his stepfather, L.K. Sewell Jr., whom he referred to as his father until his passing. Lamont accepted Christ as his personal Lord and Savior at the early age of eight along with his mother at King Solomon Baptist Church, in Detroit, MI.

He attended Oak Park High School, where he earned his Brown Belt in Tae Kwon Do, and shortly after graduating from high school in 1991, he received his first degree Black Belt. After graduating from high school, he studied Computer Aided Design & Drafting from CADD Technical School from 1991-1993, where he learned the art of technical design. Lamont was employed with Apple as an At-Home Troubleshooting Advisor, where he assisted customers with their technical issues. Until recently, he was also pursuing a degree in Information Technology from Kaplan University.

He married Danielle Fuggett on June 21, 1997, and had stayed united for 15 years - to this union three children were born. He was a father who deeply loved his children and often imparted them with his worldly knowledge, his studies of the bible and discipline.

He later met his fiance, Charlene Rieves, of Ohio, and had planned to marry this year and purchase a home, before his passing. They were inseparable

until his illness caused him to return back to Michigan.

Lamont was a "Renaissance Man" and thus, kept himself occupied with many different hobbies and was well-read in them. He was skilled at engineering music and video design, created various clothing and logo designs, and enjoyed graphics sketching and design. Lamont also had a deep understanding of computers and was well-experienced in programming, building computers and was the "go-to" person for all things technical. He was an avid reader and scholar, had written several books and was a spoken word poet, often contemplating on God, the natures of this world and his reflections about life, teaching and touching many lives through the word of God.

At the end of his passing he acknowledged his mother while in her arms with a smile, returning to God peacefully at the age of 46 on May 15, 2018.
