Larry was born in Chicago, Illinois on February 24, 1958, to the late Clarence and Carrie Mae Dixon who preceded him in death. Larry accepted Christ and was baptized at St. Mark Baptist Church in Detroit, MI under the leadership of Pastor Kirby.

He received his education in the Chicago and Detroit Public School system and graduated from MurrayWright High School in 1976. After graduation, he continued his education with Wayne County Community College.

As a Playleader, he facilitated activities in the area of baseball, basketball, and football. Due to his love for sports, he also served as a coach during various basketball tournaments at the Considine Recreational Center, where he received the nickname "Coach" from family and friends.

Larry attended Scott Memorial United Methodist Church with his sister, Janice Mashatt and nephew, Roy Hellen. He was active with the 3C's program at Scott Memorial, a ministry designed to Care, be Concerned and Committed to senior citizens, youth and children within the community. Through this ministry,

Larry participated in several activities such as their annual birthday luncheon, regional trips, Men's Day and various events sponsored by the church.

Larry bravely battled with his health over several years, and he would not give up without a fight. However, On December 13, 2018, Larry was called home to be with his Father, where he said to him, "Servant of God, job well done."
