



Mr. LaValle Darden

July 2, 1956 - September 21, 2024

Lavalle Darden was born on July 2, 1956 in Detroit, MI. He was the third child of Nancy Pearl Darden and James Darden. Lavalle accepted Christ at an early age and attended MacKenzie High School in Detroit, MI. Shortly after high school, at the age of 18, he enlisted in the Army National Guard, serving from June 18, 1974, to March 26, 1980. After six years of dedicated service, he pursued a career at CSX Railroad. He started as a carman and worked his way up to a Safety Foreman Supervisor, retiring after 36 years.”

On May 18, 1976, Lavalle married Della Reice Davis. They shared 48 years of marriage, building a loving family together in Detroit, MI. Lavalle was a devoted Christian and attended Mt. Zion Missionary Baptist Church in Detroit. His career with CSX led the family through various relocations, including Trotwood, OH; Rocky Mount, NC; Beech Island, SC; Augusta, GA; and finally back to Detroit, MI. At the time of his passing, he resided in Hephzibah, GA. Lavalle was a devoted husband, father, pawpaw, brother, uncle, son, and friend. He found joy in the simple pleasures of life bowling, fishing, classic cars, grilling, and enjoying great music. One thing everyone remembers him for is his immaculate yard. No matter where he lived or the weather conditions, Lavalle maintained a yard that was the envy of the neighborhood. Lavalle had a unique presence that left a lasting impression wherever he went. Whether it was his infectious smile or his signature celebratory fist pump with a shout of “Ho -Ho,” he could brighten any room. He shared a unique and special bond with his grandchildren-they were truly his world. He was always

there for them, whether fixing things, building or taking them apart, being a listening ear or simply making sure they were taken care of.

On September 21, 2024, Lavallo lost his battle with cancer, just 26 days after his diagnosis, while visiting family in Detroit, MI. He was preceded in death by his father, James Darden; his grandparents, Isiah Wynn (Katie) and Mary Wynn; his uncle, Isiah Wynn Jr; his aunt, Cecilia Wynn; his nephew, Larry "Peanut" Darden and Best friend Winston Ware.

Lavallo leaves to cherish his memory his loving wife of 48 years, Della Darden; his mother, Nancy Darden; three daughters: Latisha Eccles (Dennis), Markeisha Darden, and Lashawn Humphrey (Johnnie); one son, Lavallo Fields; nine grandchildren: Jayla, Michael, Janiya, Mark, Briana, Jayden, Janyah, Ravon (RJ) and Kaelani (KK). Plus six bonus grandchildren Lil Shawn, Nicholas, Kai, Cameron, Karrington and Colby. He also leaves behind four brothers: Larry, Eric (Naomi), Harold (Tia), and Charles (Cher); two sisters: Michelle and Denores; and his closest friend, Eddie Ware. He will be remembered by a host of nieces, nephews, cousins, in-laws, and friends.
