Celebrating The Life Of Lisa Nicole Davis:

Lisa Nicole Davis was born on January 17, 1967 in Detroit, Michigan. She was the eldest child born to the union of Ervin H. Davis (who preceded her in death) and Gwendolyn (Matthews) Davis. Lisa accepted Christ as her Lord and Savior in her youth. She was a member of several congregations during her lifetime.

Lisa was educated in the Detroit Public School system, graduating from David Mackenzie High School. As a young teenager, Lisa demonstrated an innate talent for the art of cosmetology. Family and friends came to the basement “beauty shop”, where she creatively coiffed and braided the hair of the Monte Vista block children and others. Therefore, it was not surprising that following high school she enrolled in a cosmetology program at Virginia Farrell Beauty School in Detroit, Michigan, earning a cosmetology license in 1988. Lisa worked in various hair salons in and around Detroit, as well as, continuing her home enterprise. As a hairstylist, she referred to herself as a “trendsetter”.

Lisa enjoyed music and sports, especially viewing boxing matches, a pastime that she shared with her father. She also enjoyed socializing with family and entertaining friends. Lisa was described by others as a generous, loving free-spirit, in fact, she was a “people magnet”, who did not meet a stranger. She developed friendships that lasted a lifetime.

At 22 years old, when it seemed that she was at the beginning of a successful career as a hairstylist and ready to take on the traditional challenges of adulthood, Lisa was diagnosed with a life-altering disease: Multiple Sclerosis (M.S.). During her nearly 30-year battle with M.S., while going from ability to disability, instead of becoming a hairstylist she became a hero. She maintained her loving, jovial manner and became an example of strength, fortitude and motivation to others. Lisa had many hospitalizations during the course of her life with M.S., and she came to know many of her caregivers. At her last hospital stay, one of the nurses who had cared for her many times before related a story that she had told Lisa's mother once before of how Lisa had given her solace with motivational words.

On Friday March 16, 2018, Lisa departed this life leaving us this message: it is possible to persevere through trials and tribulations with grace; or to put in simpler words "no matter what, press on to a good ending."
