Lisa worked as a Direct Care Giver, taking care of mentally and physically ill people who

Lisa also had a passion for singing and cooking. She loved her music. When she had a dinner gathering people came. Her cooking brought joy and happiness, her macaroni and cheese was something people fussed over if they saw you with too much on your plate. Leaving Detroit, Lisa decided to move to Jackson, MI where her children lived. Upon being in Jackson only four days. Lisa had a heart attack that took her life at the young age of forty-eight.
