Lonnie Young, Jr. was born in Detroit, Michigan on February 27, 1957. He was the second of four children born to the union of Annie Ruth and Lonnie Young, Sr., who preceded him in death. He was also preceded in death by a younger sister, Loretta Young.

Known affectionately as “Junior,” he was educated in the Detroit Public School system.

On June 25, 1976, Lonnie was united in holy matrimony to Wanda Marie Young, who also preceded him in death. To this union was born two children, Nicole Marie Young and Lonnie Young, III. They were married for 38 years until her passing in 2015.

Junior worked a host of positions prior to retiring in 2005 including Chrysler, Northville Psychiatric Hospital and the Michigan Department of Corrections. From these jobs came a large community of friends and second “family” members, many whom Lonnie stayed in touch with well after retirement.

Lonnie was a very dedicated husband, proud father, brother, son and devoted friend. He enjoyed a range of hobbies including playing basketball, which he was a member of several leagues and barbecuing for company picnics. He was known to be very loving and supportive towards everyone within his

reach.

Lonnie departed this life on December 22, 2017 at Sinai-Grace Hospital.
