At an early age she developed a love for music and dancing and began to nurture her love for teaching. She later decided to enroll at Fort Valley State College to pursue a degree in Education. She was very strict with homework which included, English and mathematics. She was proud to be her children's first teacher and tutor. She passionately loved gardening, playing basketball, watching her "boys", the Detroit Pistons on television, listening to her favorite radio hosts Martha Jean The Queen and more recently Steve Harvey.

Lucile married the late Willie George Swift on June 26, 1956 and moved to Detroit, Michigan in 1957. To this union seven children were born. She always valued the importance of family and maintaining a safe and loving home. The life Lucile lived was a testament of her strength, diligence, and perseverance. The words, "I can" and "I will" were highly regarded by her, but the words "can't" and "impossible" were discouraged. She later joined Jamison Temple Missionary Baptist Church under the leadership of Pastor Homer Jamison and Co-Pastor Royal Jamison where she remained a faithful member serving on

the Mother and Usher Auxiliary Boards.
