Lucille Hamilton was born on January 29, 1911 in Lexington, Georgia to the late John and Ann Young. She was one of eight children (Harold, Frank, Harvey, Nona, Ruby, Odessa and Bernice). She married Robert Hamilton in 1929 and from this union nine children were born. It was a home filled with lots of joyful memories. Her husband and two of her children (Bobby and Sherry) preceded her in death.

Lucille was sometimes called Drue by her family and friends but she was mostly known as "Mother" and Mrs. Hamilton. Her genteel and courteous personality was born from her southern upbringing. A devoted, loving mother, Lucille's foremost obligation was to her children. She didn't hesitate in rolling up her sleeves and putting a switch to those disobedient legs. Mother was no wilting flower. She was strong and healthy far into the latter years of her life. Mother was a classy, dignified, and beautiful mama but she was tough.

Lucille enjoyed music. She played the piano and was always humming and playing her Kingdom songs. Her love of music rubbed off on her children. She was proud of all her children and loved by many. Her home was adorned with pictures of her family who loved her. Lucille loved flowers and plants, many of which adorned her home.

With love for God and the desire to make his heart rejoice Lucille dedicated

her life to Jehovah and was baptized as one of Jehovah's Witnesses on July 31, 1977. She was a voracious reader primarily of the Bible and literature. She kept up with world events, always assigning them to biblical prophecies. She always enjoyed the field ministry until her health began to slow her down, but she didn't stop preaching about the good news of God's Kingdom. She shared words of wisdom and wrote many letters of encouragement to her family. Until the end of her life, at the age of 102 she was in regular attendance at her weekly meetings, listening in by telephone. Her faith was deeply rooted in God's promises. She believed fully in His promise of a resurrection to life in an earthly paradise.
