Marjorie Duncan Stubbs was born to Ira and Vesta Duncan on August 20, 1935 in Howard, Georgia.

She was one of five children, two of whom preceded her in death, brothers Ira (Mary) and Leonard (Geraldine). Marjorie was baptized at an early age at Philadelphia Baptist Church, which also served as the local school where she received her education in a small one room schoolhouse. During her childhood, Marjorie loved to play sports, running relay races was her favorite, and nearly always was the winner. She enjoyed sharing stories with her children how she used to pick cotton while growing up in the south. Marjorie developed a love for cooking and baking cakes, as a cook in the bakery at Warner Robins Air Force Base in Warner, Georgia. Marjorie came to Detroit to visit a few times before making it her permanent home. She met and married Gus Stubbs, and they were later divorced. Marjorie obtained gainful employment at Ford Motor Company in Wixom, MI where she worked until her retirement.

Marjorie (Sista Stubbs) united with Galilee Missionary Baptist Church in 1956, where she was a faithful and dutiful steward until her health permitted otherwise. Marjorie will always be remembered for her sense of humor, her ability to make others laugh, and the smile she always had whenever you saw
